The board will seek to establish a satisfactory working relationship with governmental and private agencies having an interest in the operation of the cooperative.

LB School-Community Cooperation

LB

The board will seek to foster an atmosphere of cooperation between the cooperative and community groups and organizations.

The board will consider the establishment of programs sponsored jointly by the cooperative and community groups or organizations whenever, in the judgment of the board, such programs cannot be or should not be wholly under the control of the board.

LDD Federal Government-Drug Free Schools

LDD

The unlawful possession, use, sale or distribution of illicit drugs and alcohol by students or cooperative employees on cooperative premises or as a part of any cooperative activity is prohibited. This policy, and any curriculum used in conjunction with it, shall be evaluated at least every-other year using criteria developed by the director and approved by the board. The board shall receive a report after each of these reviews is conducted. This policy is required by the 1989 amendments to the Drug Free Schools and Communities Act. P.L. 102-226. (See IDAB, GAOA, GAOB, and JDDA)
